



Under the new covenant of grace the Lord will no more remember your sin.

Hebrews 8:12-13

And I will forgive their wickedness, and I will never again remember their sins.” When God speaks of a “new” covenant, it means he has made the first one obsolete. It is now out of date and will soon disappear.

Romans 4:6-8

David also spoke of this when he described the happiness of those who are declared righteous without working for it:

“Oh, what joy for those whose disobedience is forgiven, whose sins are put out of sight. Yes, what joy for those whose record the Lord has cleared of sin.”

Isaiah 43:25

“I—yes, I alone—will blot out your sins for my own sake and will never think of them again.



We cannot be saved or justified or forgiven by what we do, it’s only by Grace when we place our faith in Jesus Christ.

Galatians 2:16

Yet we know that a person is made right with God by faith in Jesus Christ, not by obeying the law. And we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we might be made right with God because of our faith in Christ, not because we have obeyed the law. For no one will ever be made right with God by obeying the law.”

Ephesians 2:8

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can’t take credit for this; it is a gift from God.

Acts 13:38-39

“Brothers, listen! We are here to proclaim that through this man Jesus there is forgiveness for your sins. 39 Everyone who believes in him is declared right with God—something the law of Moses could never do.

Romans 3:27

Can we boast, then, that we have done anything to be accepted by God? No, because our acquittal is not based on obeying the law. It is based on faith.

Conclusion

It is therefore quite simple to be saved and receive the eternal blessings of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ:

Romans 10:8-11

In fact, it says, “The message is very close at hand; it is on your lips and in your heart.”[a] And that message is the very message about faith that we preach: 9 If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved. 11 As the Scriptures tell us, “Anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced.”

It is by grace and grace alone that we receive all blessings in every area of our lives.

Titus 3:5-7

he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit. He generously poured out the Spirit upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior. Because of his grace he declared us righteous and gave us confidence that we will inherit eternal life.

Romans 4:13

Clearly, God’s promise to give the whole earth to Abraham and his descendants was based not on his obedience to God’s law, but on a right relationship with God that comes by faith.

Acts 20:32

And now I entrust you to God and the message of his grace that is able to build you up and give you an inheritance with all those he has set apart for himself.

I pray that there would be a spiritual renewal of your thoughts and attitudes as you receive this message of God’s grace through Christ.

THE NEW COVENANT OF GRACE

A PERSONAL BIBLE STUDY

All Bible references are from The New Living Translation (NLT)

Hebrews 10:12
But our High Priest offered himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then he sat down in the place of honor at God’s right hand.

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What is the good news of Grace?

Grace is the **unearned, unmerited and undeserved** favour of God upon our lives. It is God still loving us in spite of our sins, weaknesses, faults and shortcomings.

This is God's love for us demonstrated:

Romans 5:8

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

It is the gospel (good news) of grace that brings people to God:

Acts 15:11

*We believe that we are **all** saved the same way, by the undeserved grace of the Lord Jesus.*

Titus 2:11

*For the grace of God **has been revealed**, bringing **salvation to all** people.*

We are therefore new covenant believers living under grace when we believe that Christ died on our behalf taking away all our sins.

Matthew 26:28

*...for this is **my blood**, which **confirms the covenant** between God and his people. It is poured out as a **sacrifice to forgive the sins of many**.*



We are completely forgiven of all our sins (past, present and future) by the shed blood of Jesus Christ.

Romans 3:23-24

*For **everyone has sinned**; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. **Yet God**, with undeserved kindness, **declares that we are righteous**. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins.*

Ephesians 1:7

He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins.

Colossians 2:13

You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins.

Isaiah 44:22

I have swept away your sins like a cloud. I have scattered your offenses like the morning mist. Oh, return to me, for I have paid the price to set you free.



Jesus Christ was punished for our sins. Therefore we will never be punished nor condemned or experience God's anger

Romans 3:24-25

*Yet now God in his gracious kindness **declares us not guilty**. He has done this through Christ Jesus, who has freed us by taking away our sins. For God sent Jesus to take the punishment for our sins and to satisfy God's anger against us. We are made right with God when we believe that Jesus shed his blood, sacrificing his life for us.*

Romans 8:1

So now there is no punishment for those who belong to Christ Jesus.

Romans 5:9

And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly save us from God's condemnation.

Isaiah 54:9-10

Just as I swore in the time of Noah that I would never again let a flood cover the earth, so now I swear that I will never again be angry and punish you. For the mountains may move and the hills disappear, but even then my faithful love for you will remain. My covenant of blessing will never be broken," says the Lord, who has mercy on you.



Now we are made righteous (to be in right standing) in God's sight when we believe in Christ our faith is now in Christ.

Romans 4:24-25

...for our benefit, too, assuring us that God will also count us as righteous if we believe in him, the one who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead. He was handed over to die because of our sins, and he was raised to life to make us right with God.

Romans 3:30

There is only one God, and he makes people right with himself only by faith, whether they are Jews or Gentiles.

Galatians 2:16

Yet we know that a person is made right with God by faith in Jesus Christ, not by obeying the law. And we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we might be made right with God because of our faith in Christ, not because we have obeyed the law. For no one will ever be made right with God by obeying the law."

Romans 9:30-32

What does all this mean? Even though the Gentiles were not trying to follow God's standards, they were made right with God. And it was by faith that this took place. But the people of Israel, who tried so hard to get right with God by keeping the law, never succeeded. Why not? Because they were trying to get right with God by keeping the law instead of by trusting in him. They stumbled over the great rock in their path.

Romans 10:1-4

Dear brothers and sisters, the longing of my heart and my prayer to God is for the people of Israel to be saved. I know what enthusiasm they have for God, but it is misdirected zeal. For they don't understand God's way of making people right with himself. Refusing to accept God's way, they cling to their own way of getting right with God by trying to keep the law. For Christ has already accomplished the purpose for which the law was given. As a result, all who believe in him are made right with God.



Christ has secured our eternal salvation by his one perfect sacrifice.

Hebrews 9:12

With his own blood—not the blood of goats and calves—he entered the Most Holy Place once for all time and secured our redemption forever.

Hebrews 9:28

...so also Christ died once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. He will come again, not to deal with our sins, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for him.

Hebrews 10:10

For God's will was for us to be made holy by the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ, once for all time.

Hebrews 10:12

But our High Priest offered himself to God as a single sacrifice for sins, good for all time. Then he sat down in the place of honor at God's right hand.

Hebrews 10:14

For by that one offering he forever made perfect those who are being made holy.

Hebrews 10:17

Then he says, "I will never again remember their sins and lawless deeds."
